COVID-19 Trip Procedures

Our Safety Philosophy

LEAD222 Continues to try to create environments that are safe and conducive to our purpose of being together in LEADmissions and LEADCamp, advancing God's Kingdom. We have updated our COVID-19 policies and procedures to where we believe they are appropriate currently. It is our intent to care for each other and the communities we will be ministering to as best as possible. Policies and procedures may be added or removed as necessary. Any changes will be communicated to you prior to your scheduled trip(s).

If someone begins to show COVID-19 symptoms:

1. That person will be isolated
2. That person will have to take a test. (cost to the student)
3. Remain isolated until either positive test prompting next set of procedures or feeling better. If a student needs to be isolated a leader must remain at the host site with them.

If anyone tests positive for COVID-19

1. Unfortunately arrangements will have to be made for that person to be sent home.
2. Anyone who has been in close contact (van, sleeping rooms, etc.) with the positive person will have to test.
 - a. These steps would not be negotiable. All logistics for this would need to be coordinated by the group leaders and the families of those affected. LEAD222 will not offer refunds in this situation.
